If you've never used PressReader before, follow these steps:

For people using the app:



1. Download the PressReader App from the App Store or Google Play
2. Open the app and tap "Have an account? Sign in." Then tap "Libraries or Groups."
3. Tap "Select Library or Group." The app may ask to access your location. Choose your preferred setting.
4. If Location Services are allowed, the library may pop up automatically. If not, simply search "Saskatchewan Public Libraries." Choose the option that says "Library - Saskatchewan Public Libraries (Ministry of Education) (Offsite)."
5. Type in your library card number and PIN*** Check the box beside "Stay signed in," then tap "Sign in."
6. The app will prompt you from there. You will then be able to browse all publications, search for the title/issue you want in different categories/languages/countries, and download titles as you wish.

How to set up PressReader (continued)

For people using a computer:

1. Go to **southeastlibrary.ca**
2. Click on the "E-Resources" tab, click "All E-Resources and Databases," then click the PressReader logo at the top of the page under "Most Popular."
3. You will be prompted to enter your library barcode and PIN. Once entered, click "Login."
4. If your barcode or PIN is incorrect, the site may prompt you to enter a username and password. You do not have to enter these, simply return to the original login page and ensure both your barcode and PIN are typed in correctly.
5. Once logged in, you will be able to browse titles.
