If you've never used Libby before, follow these steps:



1. Download the Libby App from the [App Store](#) or [Google Play](#).
2. The app will ask if you have a library card. Tap "Yes."
3. You can choose "I'll Search For a Library" or "Guess My Library" (your device must have location services turned on for this to work)
4. If you chose to search, type Saskatchewan Library Consortium. If you chose "Guess My Library," be sure that Saskatchewan Library Consortium is the available option. Once you've found it, tap "This Is My Library."
5. Be sure that Southeast Regional Library is selected as your library. If another region is selected, tap "Choose Another Location" and scroll down to find the right region.
6. Type in your library card number, and then type in your PIN.***
7. The app will prompt you from there, and you can start browsing for eBooks/eAudiobooks.
8. Once inside the app, it's easiest to simply **stay logged in.**

How to set up Libby (continued)

For people using a computer:

1. Go to southeastlibrary.ca
 2. Click on the "E-Resources" tab, click "All E-Resources and Databases," then search or scroll down to "[Library2Go](#)"
 3. Click the link to go to the Library2Go home page. Click "Sign in" in the top right corner.
 4. In the drop-down menu that follows, choose "Southeast Regional Library" again. Type your card number and PIN, then tap "Sign In."
 5. You will now be able to browse through available titles to sign out or place on hold.
